


HANDLING

In German, the term "Sternenkind" (star child) is used for children who die before, during or shortly after birth. It poetically conveys comfort and hope by reflecting the idea of a beloved being who now shines among the stars.

However, there is no direct English equivalent. While terms such as "stillborn baby" or "angel baby" are used, they often lack the gentle, comforting symbolism of "star child". "Angel baby" comes closest to the meaning, but is not always used in the same context. This linguistic gap presents a challenge, as with this translation I was looking for an appropriate, equally emotive term that has a similar emotional depth in English. I now use the term "angel child" in this book. Feel inside yourself to see which term suits your situation and simply change it if necessary.

You are probably wondering about the strange numbering of the book. This is so that you don't work through the book linearly from the first to the last drawing, but bibliomantically. To do this, flip through the book with your thumb and turn to a random page. Set yourself the intention beforehand to open exactly those double pages that your emotional structure would like to look at.


The numbers support you on other levels in your painting process and come from a wide variety of cultures and sciences.
